**PAUL MCCARTNEY'S ACCLAIMED 2009 NEW YORK CONCERT  
TO AIR ON PUBLIC TELEVISION IN JUNE 2010**

*Relive the magic of McCartney's landmark NYC Beatles gig and celebrate his impressive career with the historic christening of New York's Citi Field.*

**BOSTON** (April 19, 2010) – A rock legend, a new stadium, and a roaring New York crowd combine for an electrifying concert experience in **PAUL MCCARTNEY: GOOD EVENING NEW YORK CITY**. The American Public Television-distributed music special, airing on public television stations nationwide beginning June 1, 2009, features standout hits from McCartney's remarkable career, including top songs from the Beatles, Wings, and his solo stint.

Forty-four years after the Beatles played a 34-minute, rollicking set at the original home of the New York Mets, McCartney returned to the Big Apple for a three-night run at the team's new baseball park, Citi Field. The concert revives – with a far superior sound system – historically significant numbers such as "I'm Down" from the original 1965 set list, which was completely overpowered by screaming Beatles fans during its NY concert debut. It also mixes in some more explosive tunes such as Wings classics "Live and Let Die" and "Jet," and poignant favorites like "Blackbird."
